## Stacy Siegel Featured Artist for May

From the shards of earthquake-shattered glass arises colorful, whimsical and earthy primitive jewelry handcrafted by Kailua Village Artists member, Stacy Siegel, whose creations are being featured during May at the gallery in the Outrigger Keauhou Beach Resort.

Well known for her popular hand-blown miniature perfume bottles and vases, Siegel has departed from her comfort zone and expended her creative juices into startling, different jewelry pieces. After saving all her treasured broken glass shards and recycling the unfinished blown bottles, she combined her resourcefulness with the years of accumulated experience in glass skills. Now, by mixing the old

beads, stained glass, and shattered pieces, and by slumping, fusing, furnace working, and by adding new silver accents, unique and desirable pieces are born.

Siegel moved permanently to the Big Island from Santa Fe, New Mexico in 1996 after years of apprenticeship in

the well know "Tesque glassworks." Because of technical challenges of creating detailed miniatures, her finished pieces are of the highest quality.

Come meet Stacy on Saturday, May 23 as she will be the host artist.

## Collins joins artist cooperative

The artistic talents of Megan Collins are now added to the variety of creations displayed by more than 30 local artists in the Kailua Village Artists gallery.

Being born into an artistic family on a small Atlantic island off the coast of Maine, combined with her 2003 move to Hawaii provides an environmental background for her talented and varied accomplishments, she said.

Collins' mother painted in

oils and her grandfather was famous for images of Navy launches during World War II. The gray, foggy mornings on the jagged Maine coast inspired her to write poetry and music, to sketch and design jewelry. Now, Hawaiian land and seascapes, people, animals, flowers and parrots inspire her paintings, some of which are now displayed in the gallery.

Megan will be the host artist in the gallery on June 14, 24 & 28.

## Jaeger joins artist cooperative

The latent talents of Bill Jaeger have enabled him to be accepted as the newest member of Kailua Village Artists, or KVA, cooperative group.

The beauty and craftsmanship displayed in his stained glass panels and related garden objects prompted a unanimous vote for his membership.

Though he began working in stained glass 25 years ago, he did not have time to develop his skills until his retirement from Colgate-Palmolive in New

York and his move to the Big Island in 2004. He credits his progress to his wife, Kathleen, an artist and retired art teacher.

The panels, inspired by living with the nature, weather and environment of Hawaii, are all original designs made of hand-cut glass using the copper foil method, many of which utilize thick, highly beveled clear glass. Jaeger also creates garden accent stepping stones, incorporating hand-cut stained glass. Bill will be the host artist in the Gallery May 3, 8 & 13.
